

DDA counter standards

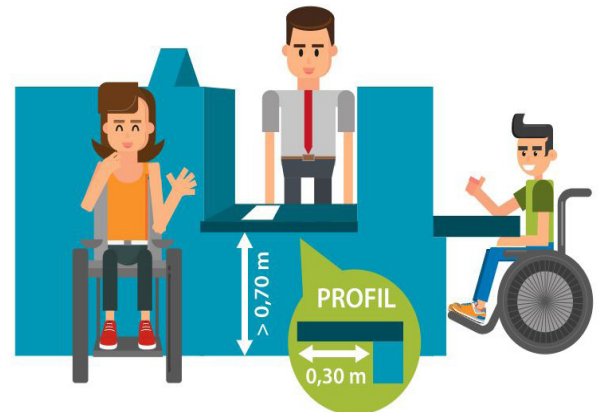
According to Law No. 2005-105 of February 12, 2005, "Equipment, furniture, control and service devices located in establishments open to the public or in installations open to the public must be able to be located, reached and used by the public. disabled people. The arrangement of the equipment must not create an obstacle or danger for people with visual impairments. » Art 11.

What are the dimensions to know for DDA furniture ?

Reception desks must be usable by a person in "standing" position as in the "sitting" position and allow the visual communication between user and staff.

To be usable in a "seated" position, here are the characteristics to remember :

- The maximum height of 80 cm and minimum of 70 cm of the void below the furniture.
- A space of at least 30 cm depth and 60 cm width is required to allow the feet and knees of a person in a wheelchair to pass through when a piece of furniture allows them to read a document, write or use a keyboard.

The Fifty-Fifty reception range can be equipped with a DDA unit whose characteristics are :

- 71.5 cm height under top
- 35 cm overhang from the worktop
- 87 cm wide

These dimensions perfectly comply with the standards in terms of useful dimensions available for a wheelchair.
